Explanation:

HP uses these supply-market terms to distinguish different risks associated with nonstandard or improperly distributed printing supplies. Grey marketing describes genuine HP product that is diverted or sold into a geographic region for which it was not intended, without HP's consent. The product itself is authentic, so the key feature is its unauthorized distribution across markets rather than its manufacture. This is why Grey marketing belongs with the definition referring to genuine HP products sold in an unintended region.

Counterfeiting concerns the unauthorized use of HP trademarks on products that were not made under an HP license. The defining issue is the false branding or representation that makes the product appear to be an authorized HP product. HP's anti-counterfeit program discusses the importance of identifying and reporting suspicious supplies and protecting customers from falsely represented products; see [HP Anti-Counterfeit](#).

Clones are newly manufactured, non-HP cartridges designed to imitate an original cartridge's form or function. They may create intellectual-property concerns, including possible use of patented technology associated with Original HP cartridges. Therefore, Clones belongs with the definition about new non-HP cartridges that might violate IP, such as patents. Keeping these definitions separate helps sales professionals accurately explain the value, provenance, and protection associated with Original HP supplies.
