It supports the end-to-end purchasing process for goods and services, including vendor management, procurement policies, purchase requisitions, requests for quotation, purchase orders, product receipts, and vendor collaboration. These capabilities help an organization source materials and services required for its supply chain while applying purchasing controls and maintaining supplier-related information.

Microsoft Dynamics Office add-in for Microsoft Excel is appropriate for editing existing customers because Excel integration lets authorized users open entity data in an Excel workbook, make changes using familiar spreadsheet features, and publish those changes back to Dynamics 365. The add-in works with Open in Excel-enabled data entities, allowing users to update multiple existing records efficiently while Dynamics 365 applies its business data validation on publish. This is particularly useful when the update is a small, user-driven maintenance task rather than a large-scale integration. Microsoft documents this workflow in [Office integration with Excel](#).

The two branches can each be configured with an approval element for the appropriate approver or approval group. After the parallel branches are completed according to the configured completion policy, the workflow can continue to subsequent steps or complete the requisition workflow. This design supports independent review while preserving a single requisition workflow process and a clear audit trail of both approval outcomes.

Dynamics 365 Finance supports each capability represented in the answer area. Segregation of duties is available through the security framework and is used to identify or prevent conflicting responsibilities from being assigned to the same user. Organizations can define duties, privileges, and conflict rules so that sensitive financial activities are appropriately separated among users. This provides an important internal-control mechanism for finance operations. Microsoft describes the setup and management of these controls in its [segregation of duties documentation](#).

The application also supports workflow-based approval processes for vendor invoices. A workflow can use conditions, including invoice monetary amounts, to route an invoice for approval when it exceeds a defined threshold such as \$10,000. Workflow participants can receive notifications and work items so that they are alerted to approvals requiring their action. This lets a company apply its approval policy consistently while retaining an auditable workflow history. Finally, Dynamics 365 Finance includes Financial reporting for producing formal financial statements and management reports. This includes personal and contact details, subject to the organization's security and configuration. An employee can therefore update information such as a home address and phone number without needing an HR representative to make every routine change. Employee self-service also supports leave and absence processes. Employees can create and submit requests for time off, allowing the request to follow the organization's configured approval workflow. Inventory journals provide a controlled way to record physical inventory activity while applying the appropriate inventory and financial posting behavior. The correct mapping uses the journal designed for each operational purpose. A movement journal is used when inventory must be issued or received with a financial offset that can be selected for the transaction, such as charging the value of an item to a different department rather than using the item's usual posting setup. A transfer journal records an internal move of inventory from one warehouse to another warehouse in the same legal entity.

An inventory adjustment journal is appropriate when inventory is added and a cost must be entered for that receipt. Posting the adjustment updates the item's on-hand quantity and value and creates the related ledger transaction. A counting journal supports a physical stock count: users enter the counted quantity and, after posting, the system adjusts the registered on-hand quantity to agree with the actual quantity found in the warehouse. These journal types therefore align the operational event, inventory update, and financial impact correctly. Explanation:

When a customer has selected merchandise but intends to return later the same day to pay, the POS user should suspend the transaction. Suspending preserves the active basket, including the items, quantities, prices, discounts, customer information, and other transaction details already entered. This allows the cashier to stop the current checkout without losing the sale and makes the register available to serve the next customer. In practical terms, suspension is the POS process that holds the customer's items in an unfinished sale while payment is deferred.

When the customer returns, the cashier should recall the transaction. Recall retrieves the previously suspended transaction into the POS so the cashier can review the basket, make any necessary updates, accept payment, and finalize the sale. Together, these two functions support the intended workflow: first retain the customer's pending purchase, then reopen it later for checkout. Microsoft's Commerce POS documentation describes suspended transactions as transactions that can be retrieved and completed later, and it documents recalling suspended transactions from the POS transaction functions. Therefore, use Suspend transaction for holding the items, and use Recall transaction when the customer returns to complete the sale. This preserves the original customer basket and provides a smooth, accurate continuation of the sale at a later time.

Vendors can submit invoices electronically by creating and submitting vendor invoices in the collaboration interface, where the invoices are then available for the customer organization to review and process. This reduces manual document exchange and supports a more streamlined procure-to-pay process.

Vendors can also confirm purchase orders. They can review purchase-order information that has been shared with them, update relevant delivery details when permitted, and submit confirmations to communicate whether and how they will fulfill the order. Purchase-order confirmation gives the buying organization current information for planning and follow-up.

Responding to a request for quote (RFQ) is another vendor collaboration function. A vendor can review an RFQ received from a customer, enter quotation details such as prices and delivery terms, and submit the response for the customer's evaluation.
